A missionary serving in **Mozambique** wrote..."We live in a part of Mozambique where missionaries are few & far between. The Bible is not available in peoples mother tongue & low levels of literacy mean that it is very hard to make use of written resources. This is

where we have found the **Saber MP3 player** an exciting addition to our arsenal as we seek to teach & equip Mozambican leaders & to establish churches in towns and villages throughout the Tete province. A number of our evangelists have been moving from house to house playing the Good News to assembled friends & family with the colourful flip charts an essential tool in helping people to follow the talk. We have also included some audio recordings from The New Testament in Chewa, the predominate language in Malawi & similar in parts to Nyungue. However Wycliffe Bible translators have recently completed Johns Gospel in Nyungue & we have this loaded onto the Saber units. Now people can now listen in their own language."



WEC YOUTH CAMP...When a local WEC missionary shared about our new Saber MP3 player at a recent WEC youth camp they decided to give their offering to Language Recordings UK to buy some of these amazing machines. The gifts amounted to £591. This has enabled us to send 20 free Saber players...This was a great surprise and blessing. Four machines have gone already



to **Sudan** in the boxes we sent out this week. Many thanks to our WEC friends, youth & leaders at the summer camps.

Steve Taylor was warmly welcomed as a new Board member at our last meeting. Steve has great experience from many years as a sound recordist & camera man with the BBC. He also

brings experience from another Christian mission that he is involved in. Steve is married to Debbie & has 2 daughters Heather & Joanna. We praise The Lord for this new appointment.

Steve's daughter **Heather**

took part in this years Adidas Womens 5K Challenge held in London's Hyde Park on 6th September & raised funds for the work here. Praise the Lord & a BIG thank you to **Heather** & to all her sponsors.



Following our last shipment to Sudan...we have this week sent another 4 large parcels full with over 400 cassettes, MP3 players, Tape Talk players, flip charts & books. Many of the recordings were in the Zande language. They were sent via Uganda & on by MAF to the remote regions in Sudan. Pray that many will hear this Good News.

One of our offices in **Asia** are producing & distributing over 700 CDs each month. **Mexico**...are giving out 1500 CDs each week during an outreach there. In **Siberia** recordings have been done in some of the different ethnic & linguistic groups there & more are planned. Our offices around the globe are distributing 1000s of recordings every month.

We give thanks to The Lord for all our teams around the world. We pray for safety, provision & good health to enable them to reach those who have never heard the Good News in their language.



Kosova.. This was my 3rd trip to Kosova & I was accompanied by 2 friends from other missions. Between the 3 of us we had 12 suitcases (276 kilos) filled with hundreds of CDs, DVDs, flip charts, picture books & other gifts/toys to give out. We visited the Goran region, where we gave out some new recordings on CD & DVD. We spent the day in one of the Goran villages. We told the people God loves them & has not forgotten them. We met many new friends & they invited us back to record some Goran songs which we will put on our next Gospel recordings on CD & DVD.



We spent time in the Romany camps & my eyes were opened to the many needs of the people there. We gave out lots of aid & gifts & we included our recordings in Albanian. Most have large families. I asked one grandfather how many grandchildren he had, he said "I'm not sure maybe 25" his wife nodded in agreement. We sat in their makeshift homes & gave sweets to the kids. We prayed with each family. **In 1 John 3 v 17** it says, "If anyone has material possessions and sees his brother in need but has no pity on him, how can the love of God be in him?" This is a real challenge to us all.
